CHICAGO - No. 23/21 DePaul looks to extend its winning streak to six games when it confronts talented Creighton on Wednesday in a showdown of the two teams picked to win the BIG EAST regular-season title by the conference coaches.

The Blue Demons and Bluejays tip at 7 p.m. and the game will be broadcast on the BIG EAST Digital Network which can be accessed at foxsportsgo.com. GameTracker is available while in-game scoring and updates can be followed on Twitter -- @DePaulAthletics and @DePaulWBBSID.

DePaul (11-4, 3-0 in the BIG EAST) is coming off a 61-56 comeback victory over a stubborn Providence ball club on Monday night in which Brooke Schulte made her first five shots en route to scoring a game-high 23 points. It was her fifth-straight game scoring in double figures.

The Blue Demons are off to a fast start in the conference season after capturing the last three regular-season titles and sporting a 49-8 BIG EAST record in that span. They also won the conference tournament in 2014 and 2015.

Coach Doug Bruno's team is No.2 in the nation in assists, assist/turnover ratio and three-point baskets. DePaul is No. 3 in assists per game, No. 4 in three-point field goals per game and threepoint attempts, No. 12 in scoring offense and No. 13 in rebounds.

Jessica January is No. 17 in the country in assists per game and No. 18 in total assists. January & Co. lead the BIG EAST in scoring offense, scoring margin, assists, assist/turnover ratio, turnover margin, three-point field goals per game and rebounding offense.

Creighton (9-4, 3-0) is riding a five-game winning streak behind Audrey Faber (14.4 points per game), Brianna Rollerson (11.3) and Marissa Janning (11.1) who combine for nearly 37 points a game.

DePaul ranks third in D-I in assists per game... season-best 35 assists at Loyola which ranks as the second most in school history... ranks second in total assists with 319.

• DePaul ranks second in D-I with 152 3-pointers this season... 10.1 3-pointers per game ranks fourth...set a school record with 19 triples against Syracuse on Nov. 27.... ranks fourth with 475 3-point attempts this season.

• Outside of assists and threes -- DePaul ranks in the top 25 in the NCAA categories of assists-to-turnover ratio (second -- 1.52), scoring offense (12th -- 82.3) and total rebounds (13th -- 637).

• DePaul has played five teams that were either ranked or receiving votes at the time of competition... since defeating Northwestern (Nov. 19), the Wildcats have been receiving votes in both national polls.

• DePaul has played an arduous schedule -- four ranked teams (Connecticut, Notre Dame, Baylor and Syracuse) while two other teams were/are receiving votes in the National Polls (Western Kentucky and Northwestern)... Temple was also receiving votes in both the national polls to start the season.

• According to the NCAA "toughest schedule" based on opponent's wins and losses DePaul has played the 18th toughest schedule.

• For the fourth straight season, DePaul was picked as the BIG EAST Preseason Favorite... Creighton and DePaul were chosen by the coaches as the co-favorites

• Jessica January was named the Preseason BIG EAST Player of the Year... Brooke Schulte joined DePaul on the preseason All-BIG EAST team.

• January is one of 20 candidates for the Nancy Lieberman Award... last season, January was on the list of 10 finalists

• January was named to the Preseason Naismith Watch and the Wooden Watch list... is the only player for the BIG EAST on either of the lists.

• January has been honored by the BIG EAST in five of the eight weeks this season... twice was named the Player of the Week and three times to the Weekly Honor Roll.

• In the last three seasons DePaul has averaged 20.02 assists per game... this year, DePaul is averaging 21.3 assists per game.

NCAA RPI: DePaul is No. 14 in the RPI that the NCAA released on Dec. 31 (through games played on Jan. 2)... Creighton's RPI is No. 53.

It Could Happen: A win against Creighton would mark the second year in a row DePaul started the conference season 4-0... January needs two steals to pass Chanise Jenkins (230) for ninth all-time... Ashton Millender needs 29 points to reach the 500 career-point mark... a win would be Coach Doug Bruno's 626th at DePaul and his 666th as a head coach.

What is "DePaulBall": Given the named by broadcaster LaChina Robinson, "DePaulBall" is in-your-face swarming defense for 40 minutes which forces opponents to turn the ball over... finding the open player with an additional and precision pass... taking and making three pointers... playing fearless.

Finding the Open Player: DePaul ranks third in D-I with 21.3 assists per game... Baylor leads the nation averaging 24.3 dimes... Jessica January leads the BIG EAST and ranks 17th in D-I with 6.6 assists per game... five players -- January (86), Coleman (40), Campbell (38), Brooke Schulte (34) and Lauren Prochaska (31) all have more than 30 assists on the year.

Raining Threes: DePaul ranks second in Division I with 152 made 3-pointers this season... 10.1 3-pointers per game ranks fourth in D-I... set a school record with 19 threes in DePaul's win over

Ashton Millender leads DePaul from behind the arc with 26 3-pointers and is shooting .388 (26-67) from 3-point range... 11 of DePaul's eligible 12 players have at least one 3-pointer this season... nine different players have at least 10 triples this season.

Tough Schedule: DePaul has the 18th toughest scheduled based upon the wins and losses of its opponents which is released and updated daily by the NCAA... three of DePaul's losses have been to teams ranked in the top five at the time of competition.

Home Cookin': In 16-plus seasons at McGrath-Phillips Arena - formerly known as the DePaul Athletic Center - has proven itself as one of the toughest venues in the nation... DePaul has a 208-37 (.849) record in the arena's 245 games... there have been three perfect seasons -- DePaul went 13-0 in 2002-03, 14-0 in 2004-05 and 17-0 in 2010-11... the Blue Demons have an all-time home court record of 478-122 (.797)... in over 26 seasons at Alumni Hall, the women's basketball program won over 75 percent of its games with a 242-80 all-time record... at the Allstate Arena, the women's program has posted an all-time record of 28-5.

Ranked Teams at McGrath-Phillips Arena: DePaul is

13-21 (.382) all-time against Top 25 opponents at McGrath-Phillips Arena since the 2000-01 season... in games that DePaul has won over a ranked opponent, the Blue Demons average margin of victory was 14.0 points... since the 2010-11 season, DePaul is 7-8 against ranked opponents... DePaul has lost just 37 games since McGrath-Phillips Arena opened in 2000-01, and 21 have come to ranked teams... seven of those 20 losses were decided by three or less points.

947 in 31: Wednesday's game marks the Coach Doug Bruno's 947th game on the DePaul bench... in the midst of his 31st season at DePaul... Bruno boasts a career record of 625-322... led DePaul to 21 NCAA Tournaments including four Sweet Sixteen appearances... DePaul is one of only six programs – Connecticut, Notre Dame, Oklahoma, Stanford and Tennessee are the others – to go to the last 14 NCAA Tournaments... under Bruno's leadership DePaul has made four WNIT appearances, won six conference tournament championships and most recently the program's fifth, sixth and seventh regular-season titles, winning the last three in the BIG EAST.

Ranked Teams in Florida: DePaul joined three other ranked teams in Florida for the Gulf Coast Showcase, Nov. 25-27 in Estero, Fla... topped RV/RV Western Kentucky (77-69) and then-No. 11/18 Syracuse (108-84)... DePaul's dropped its game to then-No. 5/6 Baylor... Jessica was named to the five-person all-tournament team and nearly recorded a triple-double (18 points, career-high 13 assists and eight rebounds) in DePaul's win over Syracuse... for the tournament, January averaged 15.7 points, 7.3 assists, 5.3 rebounds and 2.3 steals.

Maggie Dixon Classic Champions: DePaul claimed the Maggie Dixon Tournament title to begin its season... defeated Appalachian State (99-58) and UAB (90-80)... Jessica January was named the tournament's MVP while Ashton Millender and Jacqui Grant were named to the All-Tournament team.

Doug Bruno's powerful impact on the game he loves resonates across the entire spectrum of women's basketball

as not only a highly successful college coach and staunch advocate of academics, but a passionate and undaunted promoter of the sport itself.

The former DePaul basketball player is heading into his 31st season as the head coach at his alma mater. Born and raised in Chicago and a product of Quigley South High School, Bruno has transformed DePaul women's basketball into a steadfast national power.

He has guided the Blue Demons to 14 consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances---a feat only the NCAA elite of Connecticut, Notre Dame, Stanford, Tennessee and Oklahoma can also claim. Since his return in 1988, DePaul has won 598 games, competed in 21 NCAA Tournaments and four Sweet Sixteen's (2006, 2011, 2014, 2016). Bruno is the fourth active Division I head coach to reach the 600-win plateau. Bruno has won 665 games as a head coach, 625 as DePaul's leader.

Bruno has worked with athletes at the highest level through his involvement with USA Basketball. Since 2009, Bruno has been an assistant coach for the USA Women's Basketball National Team. He has helped lead the USA to FIBA World Championships in 2010 and 2014, and to its fifth and sixth straight Olympic gold in London in 2012 and again in Rio in 2016.

Bruno is the only coach to be recognized twice as USA Basketball's Developmental Coach of the Year after leading the U18 team in 2006 and the U19 team in 2007 to gold medals at the FIBA Americas and World Championships.

Bruno's influence on the game extends to the WNBA. He currently assists the Chicago Sky as a consultant to the professional franchise. Thirteen DePaul players have been drafted by the WNBA, and two are currently competing on active rosters---Keshia Hampton (Minnesota Lynx) and two-time WNBA Sixth Player of the Year Allie Quigley (Chicago Sky).

Academically, the Blue Demons have been ranked in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Academic Top 25 ten times since 2006 and finishing in the top eight in in six of the last seven seasons which included a No. 2 finish in 2013. DePaul also earned the BIG EAST Team Academic Award in eight of the last nine seasons for having the top team GPA.

For all of his success, Bruno has been recog-

nized as the conference Coach of the Year numerous times. In 2005, Bruno was selected as Conference USA's Coach of the Decade. The Illinois Basketball Coaches Association (IBCA) has named him Coach of the Year on 21 occasions.

Coach Bruno has been inducted into the DePaul Athletics Hall of Fame, the Chicagoland Sports Hall of Fame and the IBCA Hall of Fame. Bruno was also awarded the Leonardo Da Vinci Outstanding Achievement in Education Award by the Sons of Italy. He received the Carol Eckman Award in 2008, presented annually to an active WBCA coach who exemplifies Eckman's spirit, integrity and character through sportsmanship, commitment to the student-athlete, honesty, ethical behavior, courage and dedication to purpose.

A true leader among his peers, Bruno completed a two-year term as president of the WBCA beginning in the summer of 2007. He is the chairman of the WBCA/State Farm All-American Committee and is the East Regional representative for the NCAA Division I Tournament selection. He serves on the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Committee, the Wade Trophy committee, represents District I on the WBCA Ethics Committee and has served as a conference captain.

For 40 years, Bruno has been involved with growing the game of women's basketball through his Doug Bruno Girls Basketball Camps. He has mentored over 75,000 young athletes, and many of his former campers have gone on to successful careers in every walk of life. Prior to returning to DePaul in 1988, Bruno spent eight seasons as the associate men's head coach at Loyola Chicago under Gene Sullivan. The Ramblers posted 17 or more wins in four campaigns, including a pair of 20-win seasons, and won three Midwestern Collegiate Conference titles. The 1984-85 team went 27-6 and reached the NCAA Sweet 16.

Bruno spent two seasons as the head coach and director of player personnel for the Chicago Hustle of the Women's Basketball League (WBL). His first team (1978-79) won the league's Midwest Division and led the WBL in 11 offensive categories as well as attendance.

During the 1973-74 season, Bruno began his coaching career as an assistant varsity boys' basketball coach at Chicago's Francis Parker High School before becoming the head boys' varsity coach at St. Vincent de Paul High School (1974-75).

Bruno was a three-year letter winner for DePaul and Hall of Fame coach Ray Meyer after playing high school basketball at Quigley South for the legendary Dick Flaiz. Bruno was a two-year starter at DePaul and led the 1971-72 squad in assists. He received his B.A. in English in 1973, and later returned to earn his M.A. in English in 1988.

Doug and his wife Patty are the parents of six sons---Bryan, Kevin, David, Brendan, Patrick and Bradley--- and the proud grandparents of 10.
